

ACADEMIC CURRICULUM

Greenview students learn and master three languages; English, Bahasa Malaysia and Arabic. The medium of instruction is English and all students are expected to converse only in English.

As a registered Cambridge centre for the Checkpoint exams, academic subjects follow the curriculum set by the Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) Board. Students in Year 6 and Year 9 sit for the Cambridge Checkpoint Examinations and the IGCSE in Year 11*. All Cambridge examination papers are prepared and marked by Cambridge examiners in England.
