The IB Diploma Programme (DP)

The IB Diploma Programme (DP) is a rigorous, academically challenging, and balanced programme of education designed to prepare students aged 16 to 19 for success at university and life beyond. The curriculum is made up of the DP core and six subject groups: studies in language and literature; language acquisition; individuals and societies; sciences; mathematics; and the arts. In addition to the six subjects, the DP core aims to broaden students' educational experience and challenge them to apply their knowledge and skills through Theory of knowledge, in which students reflect on the nature of knowledge and on how we know what we claim to know; The extended essay, which is an independent, self-directed piece of research, finishing with a 4,000-word paper; and Creativity, activity, service, in which students complete experiences and projects related to those three strands. The Scholarship

Eligibility

This scholarship is open to qualified students for entry into the IB Diploma Programme. The application can be made by any student of any nationality who either currently attends Uplands or who hopes to attend, and who can demonstrate the following criteria:

A successful applicant for the IB Diploma Programme Scholarship will be able to demonstrate:

- How they characterise the school's values and the IB Learner Profile
- An understanding of the nature of the IB Diploma Programme and how they will be able to meet the different elements of the program.
- A well rounded portfolio of excellence across all subjects.
- A particular passion and interest that they wish to pursue at Uplands.
- A commitment to serving their community.
- How an Uplands education can make a difference to their life and their community

Successful applicants will submit the following parts of the application, each of which will demonstrate how s/he exemplifies the above qualities:

- PART 1. Personal information including MyKad/passport number
- PART 2. CV and school records/reports including any school certified results (including PMR/SPM forecast results, if relevant) (Uplands students do not need to include school records/reports)
- PART 3. Personal statement (see below)
- PART 4. A letter of recommendation from a community member who knows her/him well
- PART 5. A letter of recommendation from a teacher or counsellor who knows her/him well

Successful applicants will complete the following parts of the application, each of which will demonstrate how s/he exemplifies the above qualities:

- PART 6. A series of assessments on 29th or 30th of April at Uplands
- PART 7. A selection interview.
