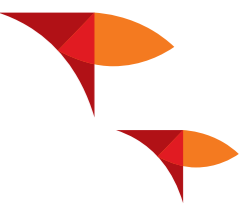

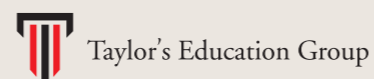

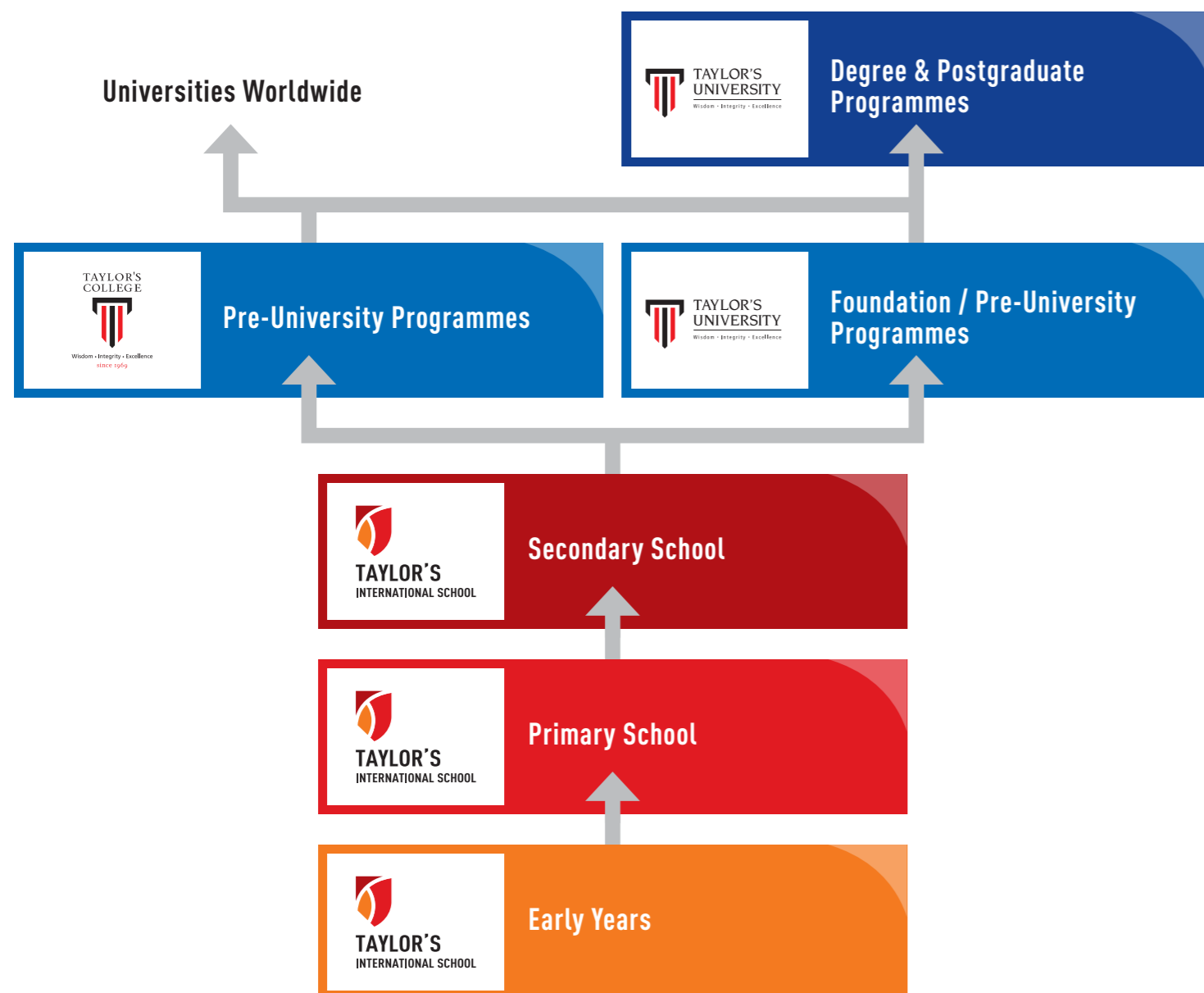

Taylor's International Schools follow the prestigious National Curriculum for England, which is highly valued worldwide. Education starts as early as age 4, and the curriculum culminates with the IGCSE examinations and qualifications at the age of 16. Our students are able to transition into pre-university courses around the world a year earlier than with the Malaysian National Curriculum.

We offer a stimulating and supportive setting, through a sound balance of academic excellence and opportunities for personal development. We have based the academic curriculum upon the National Curriculum for England but as an International Curriculum School in Malaysia, we are blending this Curriculum with living in Malaysia. Students will learn the best values of the East and West by mixing world languages, topics and culture, with those of Malaysia.



EARLY YEARS

FOUNDATION KEY STAGE

During the Early Years, the emphasis is on literacy to prepare children to read and write, with the beginning of a foundation in Mathematics. The Early Years programme is based on the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework for England, which is enhanced with Bahasa Malaysia and Mandarin. It is a foundation that nurtures positive, self-confidence in young children to help them develop thinking skills and achieve independence.

Seven areas of learning and development shape the educational programmes for early years. These areas are particularly crucial for igniting children's curiosity and enthusiasm for learning, and for building their capacity to learn, form relationships and thrive.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

KEY STAGE 1 & 2

In the Primary School, the curriculum builds on the Literacy and Mathematics skills developed in the Early Years. In addition to the core subjects, a thematic approach introduces other subjects such as Science, Humanities, Information and Communication Technology (ICT), Physical Education, Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) (or Agama) and Art and Music for children as they grow older.

The Primary School programme is based on the National Curriculum for England. At Taylor's International School, Kuala Lumpur, this is enhanced by the highly regarded International Primary Curriculum (IPC) whilst at Taylor's International School, Puchong, the National Curriculum for England stands solely on its own. Both school curricula are supported by language training in Bahasa Malaysia and Mandarin as well as using a thematic approach in many areas of Key Stage 1 and 2, which makes learning exciting and meaningful for children. Each school is consistent in focusing on personal, academic and where appropriate, international learning, which will prepare children for the world of tomorrow. Schools in more than 87 countries around the world use the IPC whilst many more countries employ the National Curriculum For England.

Key Stage 1 includes Years 1 and 2, with Key Stage 2 including Years 3 to 6.

SECONDARY SCHOOL

KEY STAGE 3

This Key Stage extends the learning, knowledge and skills of the subjects taught during the Primary Key Stages. Our course follows the National Curriculum for England, and is enhanced by international themes as well as language training in Bahasa Malaysia and Mandarin.

Students are now taught in subject groupings with the core subjects at this stage expanded to include English, Mathematics and Science. Students will also gain exposure to a wider range of subjects including History, Geography, ICT, Drama, Music, Art and Physical Education (PE) that are taught by different specialist teachers often in dedicated classrooms. This broad exposure to different subjects will help students discover different disciplines and develop their personal talents and strengths.

SECONDARY SCHOOL

KEY STAGE 4

Our Secondary School Key Stage 4 programme is the two-year IGCSE course that culminates with exams administered by Cambridge International Examinations (CIE). These IGCSE qualifications are highly recognised worldwide, and place importance in content knowledge, application and skills. They are the equivalent of SPM, however with IGCSE, students graduate a year earlier than their SPM counterparts. During this Key Stage, students will focus on a selection of subjects that include the core subjects of Maths, English and Science, with the addition of elective subjects. The elective subjects include the subjects taken at Key Stage 3, as well as new subjects such as Business Studies, Economics, Global Perspectives, and Additional Mathematics. The selection will help students keep open options for career pathways, and provide the opportunity to gain nine or ten IGCSE certificates which will surpass most university or career requirements in the future.



Science is available as a co-ordinated course, which includes all three Science disciplines that qualify as two IGCSE grades, or as the three separate Science disciplines that qualify for three IGCSE grades. For students who have a good level of English, Literature is offered to enhance their studies

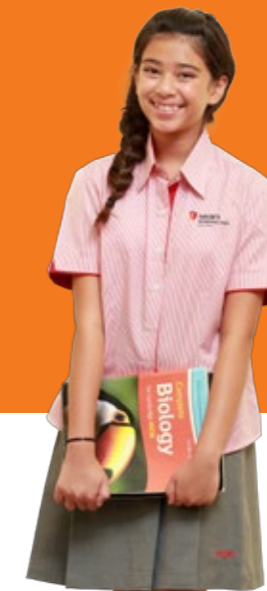

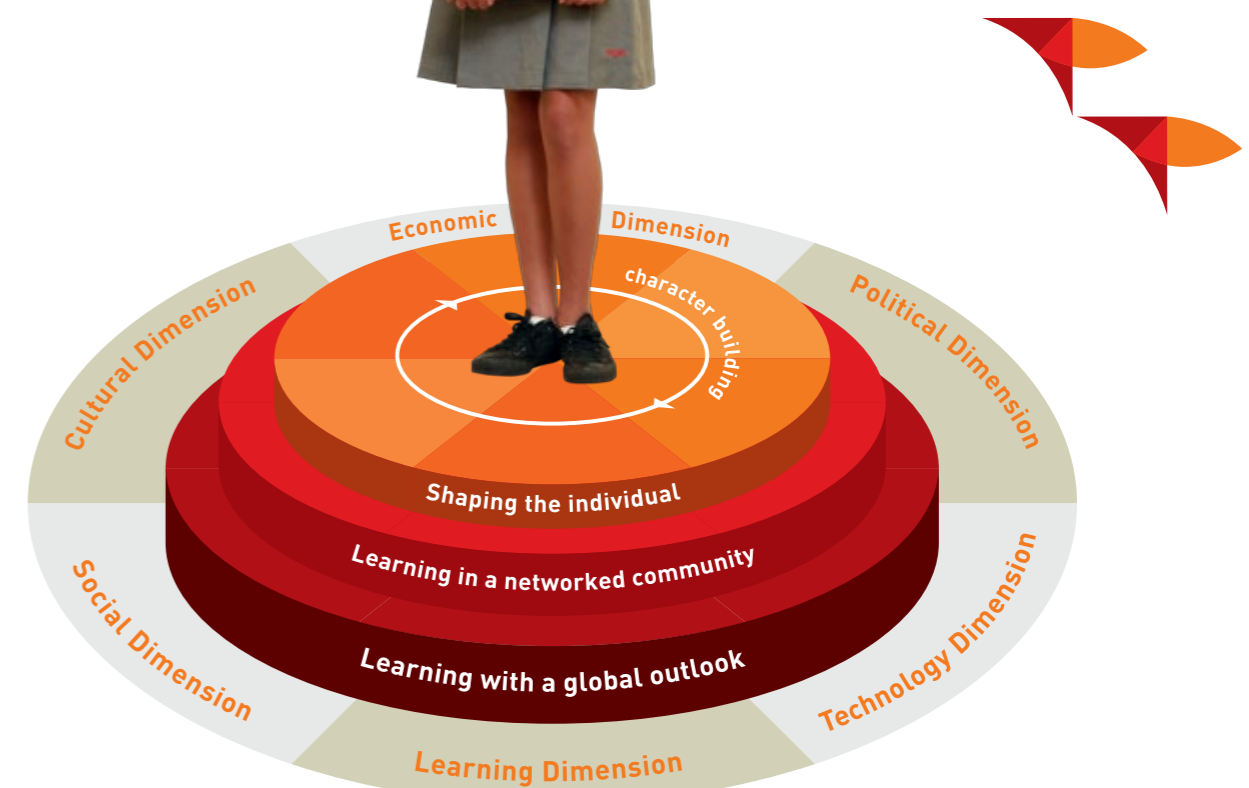


Responsible Leaders

Enhances business acumen and entrepreneurial skills.

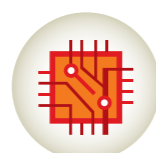

Facilities at the school are designed to help enhance a nurturing learning environment. They include a well-stocked double-storey library, science labs, design technology labs and a performing arts centre.
