Bursaries for Continuing HIS Students

All students who have completed their IGCSE programme (Year 11) at HIS will receive an automatic 30% bursary on their tuition fees equivalent to RM15,000.

The Asian Scholars **Leadership Award Scholarships**

These scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated exceptional leadership potential. Criteria include:

- · a record of service to school and community
- leadership potential as evidenced by leadership roles, projects directed and other positive values

The Asian Scholars **Academic Award Scholarships**

These scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated exceptional academic potential in the attainment of their IGCSE / equivalent results. Scholarship amount will be based on the aggregate score of A* and A as stated below:

 $A^* = 2$ points A = 1 point



Note: Students are allowed to hold multiple scholarships and bursaries. HIS students can use their mock IGCSE results to secure 50% of the scholarship amount while waiting for their actual IGCSE results.
