

#### **KEY STAGE 1 & 2**

#### AGE 6 – 11 YEARS OLD

Lower Primary are arguably the fun years of school life. In Key Stage 1, students are taught in a nurturing environment that encourages their natural curiosity in the world around them.

Upper Primary or Key Stage 2 is the intermediate stage between fun and more serious work. The school time-table for Key Stage 2 reflects a balance of academic learning alongside non-academic development. Pine Hills International places great importance on the learning of languages and students will be required to study 2 additional languages. In compliance with the Malaysian Ministry of Education, all Malaysian nationals are required to take Bahasa Malaysia as one of their second languages. The other additional language will be Mandarin. At this point of time, Mandarin is compulsory only in Year 1 and Year 2.

Cambridge Primary is for learners aged 6 to 11 years of age and the school provides a world-class curriculum to develop learner skills and understanding in English, Mathematics and Science. It enables teachers to assess children's learning as they progress with two optional assessments: Cambridge Primary Progression Tests and Cambridge Primary Checkpoint.

Cambridge Primary Checkpoint tests have been designed to assess learners at the end of Year 6. Assessments are conducted for English, Mathematics and Science, and provide valuable feedback regarding students' strengths and weaknesses before they progress to the next stage of education.

The tests are marked in Cambridge and provide schools with an external international benchmark for student performance. Each student receives a statement of achievement and a diagnostic feedback report, giving schools detailed information and parents extra trust in the feedback they receive.

Cambridge Primary Checkpoint tests are held in October.

This is the more serious stage of school life. It involves more enquiry and problem solving based learning. This increases the opportunities for independent study and enables students to make informed choices and decisions on their own.

Cambridge Lower Secondary Checkpoint tests have been designed to assess learners at the end of Cambridge Lower Secondary. They are available in English, Mathematics and Science and give valuable feedback regarding students' strengths and weaknesses before they progress to the next stage of education.

The tests are marked in Cambridge and provide schools with an external international benchmark for student performance. Each student receives a statement of achievement and a diagnostic feedback report, giving schools detailed information and parents extra trust in the feedback they receive.
