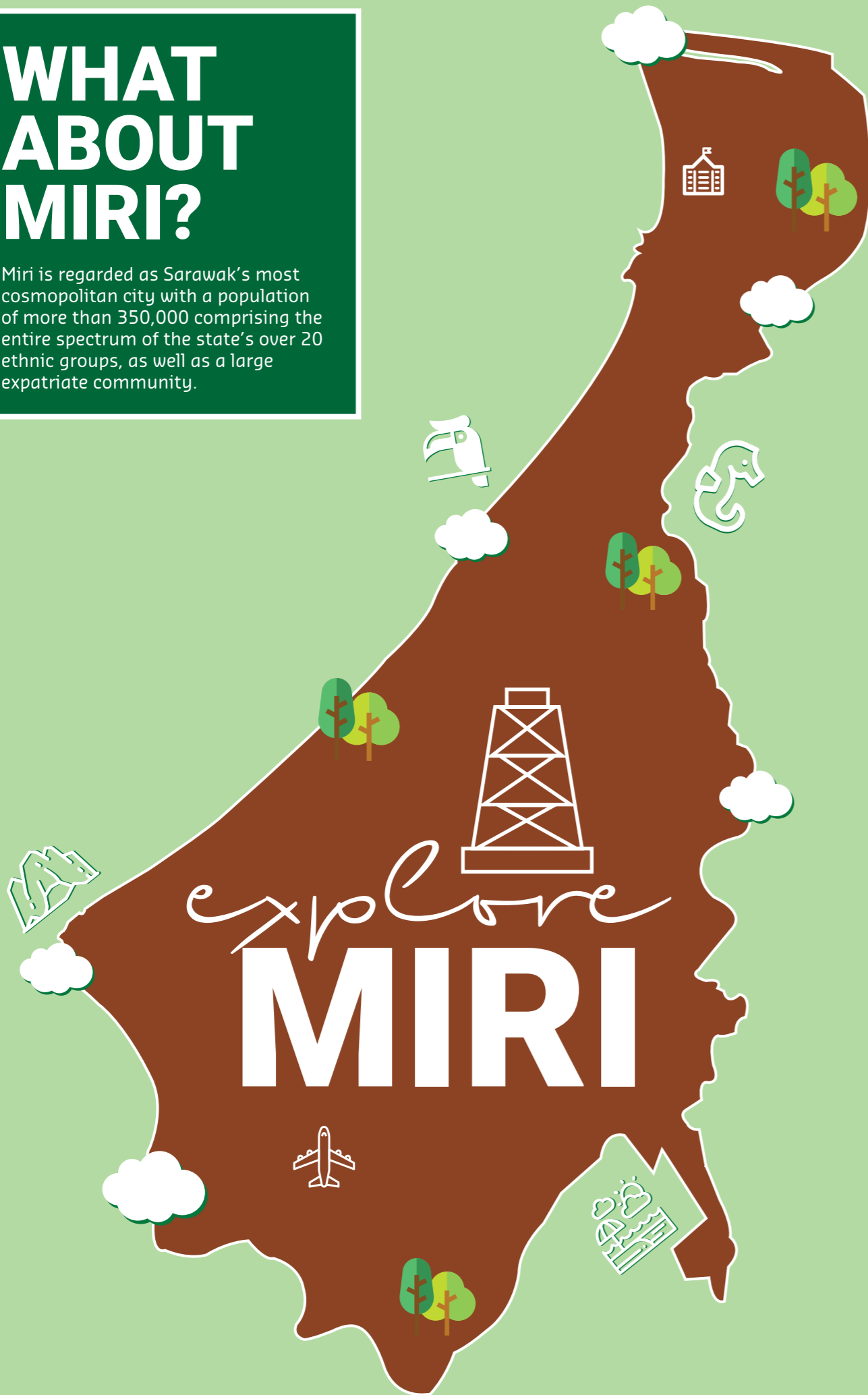

# WHAT ABOUT MIRI?

Miri is regarded as Sarawak's most cosmopolitan city with a population of more than 350,000 comprising the entire spectrum of the state's over 20 ethnic groups, as well as a large expatriate community.



## Weather



Malaysia is an equatorial country, with fairly uniform temperatures throughout the year. It is mostly summer all-year round and only a short rainy season in the later months. The average daily temperature ranges from 23°C - 32°C.

## Leisure

Leisure in Miri consists of a splendid waterfront, marina, shopping malls, two 18-hole golf courses, also sports recreation such as bowling and archery. Miri is also home of two Malaysia's premier annual international music festivals, Borneo Jazz and Miri Country Music Festival.



## Dining

In Miri, we have a diversity of cuisines to satisfy your taste buds. It varies from hawker food, local cuisines and also international franchises.



## Nature

A major tourism gateway and base to explore Sarawak's most spectacular natural attractions such as beaches, rainforests and national parks. Sarawak is renowned for its natural beauty and attractions, which includes the famous Mulu Caves, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

We are also a popular diving destination due to the abundance of spectacular patch reefs.
